

Students who succeed at MLC work on these 10 characteristics:

1) Seek Help

- a. They ask the school staff for help daily

2) Set and Achieve Goals for the Present and the Future

- a. They are able to set realistic daily goals and have plans for after high school

3) Practice Time Management

- a. They can manage time and organize tasks during their school session

4) Make Adjustments

- a. They make adjustments when behind on a goal (ie. Work at home, attend additional sessions)

5) Monitor Progress Toward Their Goal

- a. They know how to daily check their progress (ie. Calendar, APEX reports)

6) Are Self-Aware

- a. They know their academic strengths and weaknesses

7) Attend Regularly

- a. They have 3 or less absences per month

8) Control Their Environment

- a. They minimize distractions and use coping strategies to stay focused on their work

9) Take Ownership

- a. They take ownership in their academic achievement

10) Use Strategies

- a. They identify and implement strategies that help them accomplish their
